***Free and Reduced Price Meals**

Students must have an approved **18-19** Application for Education Benefits on file to receive free or reduced meal benefits. A new application must be completed each school year by Oct 1st for continuation of meal benefits from one year to the next.

Meal benefits are available to students whose families meet certain requirements such as: families might have either one or more children who receive MFIP, SNAP or FDPIR benefits, have a foster child or have a household income within certain guidelines. Free or reduced price meal benefit information is private data and is kept confidential.
