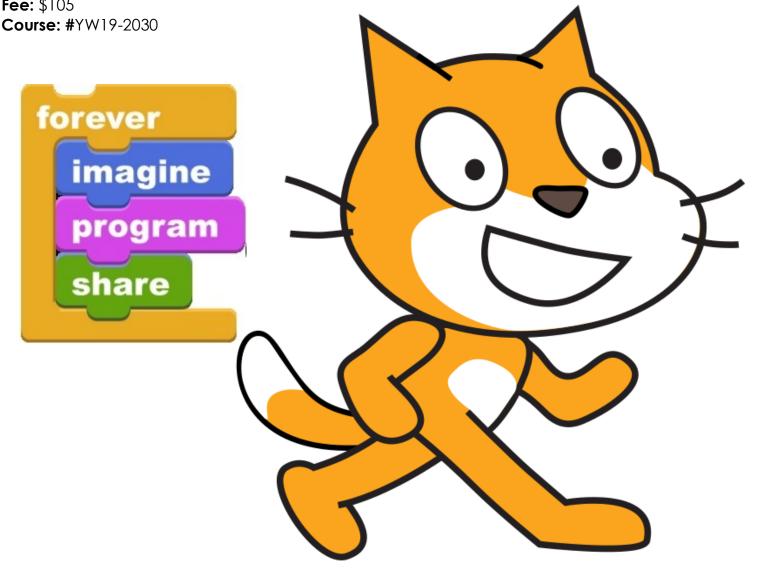
Intro to Coding with Scratch

Ultimate Game Coding

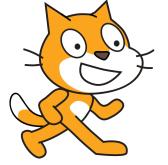
